The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council having studied the needs of juveniles in the county hereby publishes this Request for Proposals.

The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) has studied the risk factors and needs of Juvenile Court involved youth in this county and hereby publishes this Request for Proposals. The JCPC anticipates funds from the NC Dept. of Public Safety Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in the amount stated above to fund the program types specified below. Such programs will serve delinquent and at-risk youth for the state fiscal year 2026-2027 beginning on, or after, July 1, 2026. The use of these funds in this county require a local match in the amount specified below. The county can approve programs for 1 or 2 year funding awards, dependent on county approval and programs meeting all requirements.

Local match rate for JCPC funds required: **10%**.

Elevated Risk and Needs for Court Involved Juveniles:

School performance, lack of employment, substance abuse, negative peers, weapons, issues with parental supervision; display and use of a weapon; gang involvement as well as bullying/simple assaults; lack of structured and unstructured free time.
