#### **New GCC Commissioner - Nisha Williams**

Nisha G. Williams is an attorney based in North Carolina with a background in family and criminal law. She earned her degree in history from Southern Adventist University and her Juris Doctor from North Carolina Central School of Law. Since 2009, she has operated her own practice, the Law Office of Nisha G. Williams.

In 2018, Nisha joined the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence as a staff attorney and currently serves as the organization's legal director. In this role, she provides statewide training and legal advocacy to support



survivors of domestic violence. She also serves as special counsel with Indigent Defense Services, representing individuals in involuntary commitment proceedings.

Nisha was the defense attorney in State v. Berish (2018), a landmark North Carolina case that opened the door for restorative justice processes in violent felony cases before trial. She remains dedicated to improving legal access and outcomes for vulnerable populations, with a focus on domestic violence and juvenile justice reform.
