Chowan County Violence Profile




Chowan County, located in northeastern North Carolina, has a population of 13,877 and is predominantly rural. The largest city is Edenton with a population of 4,505. The closest trauma center is ECU Medical Center (64 miles from Edenton).

Violent Deaths

Chowan County had 4 violent deaths* in 2022

80% of homicides and 61% of suicides in the past 10 years involved a firearm

In 2023, Chowan County had a total crime count of 411 with 33 violent crimes*

The most common violent crimes were aggravated assault (72.7%) and rape (12.1%)


