

Person County Violence Profile



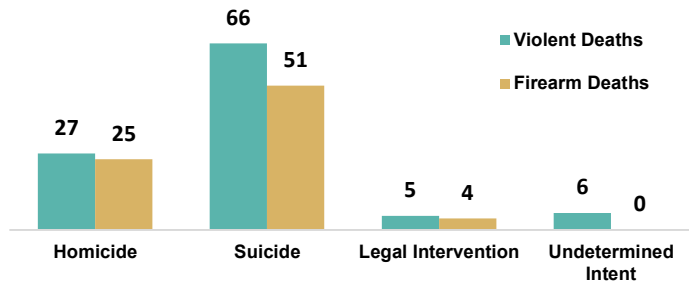
Person County, located in north-central North Carolina, has a population of 40,525 and is predominantly rural. The largest city is Roxboro with a population of 8,258. The closest trauma center is Duke University Hospital (32 miles from Roxboro).

Violent Deaths

Person County had 14 violent deaths* in 2022

93% of homicides and 77% of suicides in the past 10 years involved a firearm

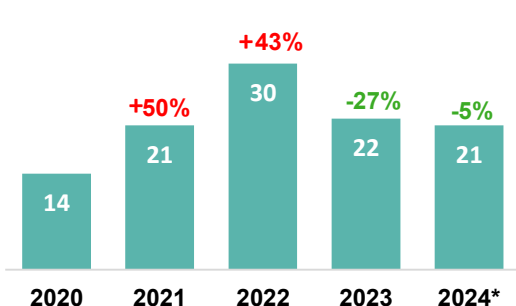

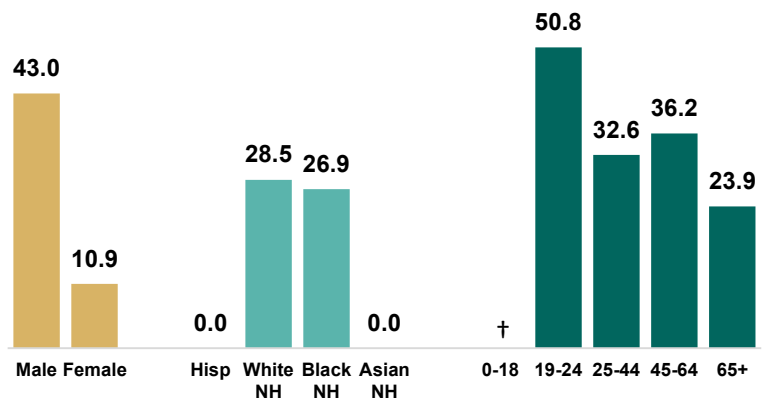

Crime

In 2023, Person County had a total crime count of 2,398 with 121 violent crimes*

The most common violent crimes were aggravated assault (74.4%) and robbery (10.7%)

*Violent Crimes include the offenses of homicide (murder and non-negligent manslaughter and negligent manslaughter), aggravated assault, rape (including sodomy and sexual assault with an object) and robbery.
