

People with access and functional needs can (and must) be accommodated in general population emergency shelters when given the proper support. Meeting the needs of people with access and functional needs requires proper planning pre-incident and proper coordination during the incident. Support for this needs to come from government, non-governmental organizations, faith and community based organizations, and private sources. **Functional Assessment**

Support Teams (FASTs) will help assess people with access and functional needs and assist them by getting what they need to stay in a shelter.
