## **PURPOSE**

To insure access to oxygen during an emergency and to provide guidelines for oxygen therapy in prison facilities.

## **POLICY**

All prison facilities will have a small, portable oxygen cylinder for emergency purposes. Facilities that have medical missions to provide care to offenders with unstable chronic disease, acute medical care including infirmary, long term care and skilled nursing care will have oxygen concentrators. Acute care and skilled nursing facilities may also have large, secured oxygen cylinders and/or wall oxygen.
