

Legislative Update

Following a one-week break for Thanksgiving, the General Assembly reconvened this past Monday. Observers of the General Assembly know that meaningful legislative activity on Mondays is fairly uncommon as the day is usually reserved for members' travel purposes. The legislature's willingness to wrap up business, and leave Raleigh for a while, was made clear based on Monday's feverish activity. Between the two chambers, votes were taken on 25 bills – one of which included an adjournment resolution.

The adjournment resolution, House Bill 979, can be accessed from the link in the table below. The House and Senate will officially adjourn December 10, 2021, until reconvening December 30, 2021. However, it is anticipated that December 30th will be a non-voting *skeleton* session and that legislators will hold off on conducting business until the arrival of the new year. In the interim, DPS Legislative Affairs will provide a summary of the General Assembly's 2021 long session to employees.
