

Characteristics of the Service Directory

- ➤ Online, real time repository of over 2,000 programs
- District Users initiate the addition of a new program via an emailed hyperlink to program entry form to a program provider.
- ► Look and feel of CJLEADS
- Automated entry update/review requests are sent to program providers every 6 months to keep it up-to-date.
- CJLEADS Users (in all CJLEADS user roles) can Search and Print entries via Pdf or Excel.




Program Entry Part II: Intervention and Treatment Areas – Risks and Needs Addressed
