# Legislative Update

Week of February 18, 2019

The pace ratcheted up at the General Assembly this week as additional appropriations committees began to meet. For the most part, committee meetings have been introductory in nature, intended to provide legislators with an overview of their assigned committee's jurisdiction. It is anticipated that appropriations committees will meet frequently over the coming months as the budget process accelerates.

At Thursday's Joint Legislative Appropriations Committee on Justice and Public Safety meeting, Deputy Secretary Tracy Little provided an update on the department's prison reform efforts. Significantly more bills were filed this week in comparison to past weeks. Twenty bills filed this week would directly impact DPS. A status update on DPS-related bills with action taken this week can be found in the table below.

As a reminder: With some exceptions, filed bills must go through the committee process and be voted on by both the House and Senate before they can be sent to the Governor for action. The Governor has 10 days from receiving the bill to either sign or veto it. If he elects to take neither action, the bill will become law without his signature.

- (4) Bills introduced on the report of the House Committees on Appropriations, Finance, or Rules.
