This week at the General Assembly, Governor Roy Cooper delivered the State of the State Address to a joint session of the House and Senate. In his address, the Governor laid out his vision for how to make North Carolina's families, communities, and economy even stronger.

The Joint Appropriations Committee on Justice and Public Safety met Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of this week, continuing their overview presentations. Juvenile Justice and Raise the Age were originally scheduled for this week but, due to lack of time, were rescheduled for Tuesday, March 5, 2019.

Sixty-three (63) bills filed this week may potentially impact DPS. An update on DPS-related bills with action taken this week can be found in the table below.

- (4) Bills introduced on the report of the House Committees on Appropriations, Finance, or Rules.
