A few things on the NC ALLIES Client Tracking Report LIST:

- Hover your mouse over the DS, FTFD, DSH, SPEP and LOS column names and the full name will appear. They are defined as follows:
 - RS Risk Score
 - FTFD Face-To-Face Days
 - DSH Direct Service Hours
 - SPEP SPEP Service Hours
 - LOS Length of Stay
- To Filter, you can click on the == or ~ to select from a list of operators, type filter data into the box and click on Enter to initiate the filter. Click the "x" to remove the filter (You can also Sort within your Filtered data if you want to)
- To Sort, you can click on any column and you'll see the up arrow to indicate ascending order. Click again and it changes to the down arrow to indicate descending order. Click again to clear the sort.
- When you double-click on a row you get a convenient, readable view of that row with buttons on the bottom to navigate to adjacent rows. (next Client either up or down)
