Legislative Update

Week of May 17, 2021

This was a quiet week at the General Assembly. A handful of committees met to hear bills, but most members experienced a reprieve. Although it was rumored that the much-anticipated Senate Budget would be released, that was not the case. The biggest news of the week came from Governor Cooper, who announced that North Carolina will receive \$5.7 billion in federal funds through the American Rescue Plan (ARP), which he proposed using to assist families most impacted by the pandemic, upgrade water-sewer infrastructure, and promote business development and innovation, among other priorities.

On Wednesday, in Senate Rules and Operations, House Bill 395, *HIE Deadline Extension & Patient Protection*, passed unanimously, after an amendment was made to extend connection deadlines until January 2023. In addition, on Thursday, the House Appropriations Committee thoroughly discussed then unanimously passed Senate Bill 172, *Additional COVID-19 Responses & Relief*.

We anticipate that for next week, the focus will be the release of the Senate Budget.
