On Wednesday, the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Justice and Public Safety heard an overview of the Senate's budget proposal, *Senate Bill 105 - 2021 Appropriations Act*. The Senate version is a starting point for negotiations; the House will certainly want to put its own stamp on the spending plan. There is a long way to go before the bill heads to the Governor for a signature.

Both the House and Senate will take a recess next week and will not be holding committee meetings or votes. The DPS Legislative Update will also pause for the recess and return Friday, July 16th.
