

## Legislative Update

*Week of June 8, 2020*

This week at the General Assembly both the House and Senate calendars were lengthy and committee meetings were in abundance. This activity seems to suggest that things are beginning to wind down. However, a number of bills affecting our department traveled successfully through the process. They are described below:

House Bill 1064, *GSC Clarifying Bingo License Statute*, which makes technical changes moving Bingo from SBI to ALE, received a favorable report in the House Committee on Rules during Tuesday's meeting. On Wednesday, the bill passed third reading on the House floor with a vote of 116 to 3. The bill is now in the Senate and will be heard in the Judiciary committee.

In addition, three other bills of significance to the department were ratified and presented to the Governor for his signature. They are as follows:

- Senate Bill 836, *State Operations/Increase Federal Funds Use --* provides \$370 million for the continuity of operations needs across state government. Specifically, these funds may be used for overtime costs at prisons, community corrections, juvenile facilities, and veterans homes, among other uses.
- House Bill 1063, *Fund VIPER Tower Hardware Upgrades* -- directs \$19,800,530 non-recurring to make critical hardware upgrades to base station equipment. This bill has been signed by Governor Cooper and goes into effect July 1, 2020.
- House Bill 1187, *Raise the Age Funding* -- appropriates funding for additional bed space needed to accommodate the anticipated increase in juveniles resulting from Raise the Age Implementation. The bill provides an appropriation of \$10,440,000 for renovations at Perquimans Youth Detention Center and C.A. Dillion Youth Development Center and for construction of the new Rockingham County Youth Development Center. Unfortunately, the bill as written directs the funds for these items to be transferred from the Statewide Misdemeanant Confinement Fund. This bill has been signed by Governor Cooper and goes into effect July 1, 2020.

Finally, as a friendly reminder, the 2.5% raises to employees from the various mini budgets passed last year will go into effect on July 1, 2020.
