CONSTRUCTION/ ELECTRICAL NCIA's Herbert J. Hoelter Vocational Training Center (VTC) provides 15 weeks of vocational training for veterans, returning citizens, and those 18 years or older on food stamps. Students receive industry recognized certifications in the vocation of their choice. VTC alumni have built careers in automotive, transportation, construction and HVAC.

- **15 weeks** of vocational training
- Industry-recognized certifications
- 12 months of post-training support
- Strong employment partners
- 75% employment rate

In addition to vocational training, the VTC provides wrap-around support services as needed including help with transportation and housing.

The vocational training program includes financial literacy, digital literacy and workforce development including resume writing and interview preparation, plus up to 12 months of post-training support. The VTC has strong employment partners and maintains a 75% employment rate for those who successfully complete the program.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, VTC programs currently include a mix of small-group, hands-on training (following state guidelines and safety recommendations), and virtual training with online simulators.
