

HMGP INFRASTRUCTURE LETTER OF INTEREST POWERPOINT SLIDES FOR PANEL BRIEFING GUIDELINES

As a first step in submitting an Infrastructure Mitigation (IFM) project for FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funding, each applicant must submit a PowerPoint file using the official slide template available at:

https://www.ncdps.gov/our-organization/emergency-management/hazard-mitigation/disaster-hazardmitigation-grants

A short instructional video is also available, outlining panel scoring and how slides are reviewed.

You will replace the sample content in the template with your project information while keeping the layout intact.

Slide 1 - Project Overview

- Project Title and Subapplicant Name Use a descriptive title starting with "To..." (e.g., "To replace four culverts...")
- Project Number Leave blank (to be completed by NCEM-HM)
- Amount Requested Total estimated project cost (100%)
- Mitigation Measures Actions to reduce hazard risk (e.g., culvert replacement, green infrastructure)
- Benefit-Cost Analysis Focus Primary benefits to be quantified (e.g., avoided damage, service protection)
- How Ready Is It? Use the scale bar and explain the current phase; projects may qualify for Advance Assistance

Slide 2 - Plan Alignment and Additional Context

- Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan Alignment Name your regional plan and cite relevant mitigation actions
- What Else Should the Panel Know? Optional, but encouraged. Briefly highlight any additional value, urgency, partnerships, maintenance, or technical insight not captured elsewhere

Formatting Tips:

- Be concise use short sentences or bullet points
- Avoid redundancy with prior slides
- Maintain formatting; avoid shrinking text or overcrowding
