Performance-Based Standards and **Expected Practices for Adult Correctional** Institutions, 5th Edition 5-6A-20;

I. **PURPOSE**

To provide offenders with patient health and wellness education information to assist them in becoming more knowledgeable of healthy living and to improve their overall health.

II. **POLICY**

- Health and Wellness staff shall provide patient education materials that are appropriate to (a) the level of understanding of the offender.
- (b) The Patient Education Committee is responsible for reviewing, developing and making available patient education materials.

III. **PROCEDURE**

- Educational materials shall be provided either verbally, written and/ or visual (videos, (a) models, diagrams).
- (b) Health and Wellness staff shall document in the patient health care record patient education provided, the method used and patient's understanding of education provided.
