NC ALLIES User Registration

1. At this point, users must already have either a Business or State/Local Government NCID Account. If not, follow the steps in the **Register for NCID** user guide.
2. Open your Internet browser.
3. Type <https://cp.ncdijdp.org/CP> in the address bar and click the **Enter** button on your keyboard to access this website.
NOTE: When the link takes you to the Login Screen, users may choose to create a desktop shortcut, bookmark, or favorite. This will allow quick access to NC ALLIES for future login.
4. Enter the Login ID (User Name) and Password used for NCID and click the **Login** button


